### **Kingdom Impact Award**

#### **MISSION STATEMENT:**

1. This individual's life and ministry should reflect a faithful example of the five core values of CIU. These are: Authority of Scripture, Victorious Christian Living, World Evangelization, Prayer and Faith, and Evangelical Unity.
2. This honor recognizes an alumnus (not necessary to be a graduate) who is a public figure and comes to CIU to speak at CIU's Chapel service or other public gathering, besides Homecoming. Their high-profile presence is due to being an evangelist, author, musician, ministry leader, etc. They must currently be serving in this role to be honored.
3. This is a discretionary honor, determined by the Director of Alumni Ministries, and is based on his/her knowledge of the upcoming chapel speakers. There is no regularity specified for this honor, in order to allow the Director to award this honor when he/she feels appropriate, without waiting until Homecoming for the honor to occur.
4. If this honoree's spouse also serves with him/her in the public capacity, both spouses would be honored together. If the spouse is not a CIU alumnus, he/she could be given honorary alumnus status.
